

## Summary Report of Meeting with First Nickel Inc.

Geoff & Bonnie Barkham and Jan Watkins met with Paul Davis, Vice President of Exploration at the head office of First Nickel Inc. in Toronto on Wed. Sept 12/07. Geoff & Bonnie were representing Twin Sisters Gemson Properties Ltd. and Jan was representing the Rate Payers Assoc. The purpose of the meeting was to determine what future plans First Nickel Inc., a publicly owned company, might have for our area as they have filed a claim for mining rights to properties around East and West lakes on June 26/07 at a cost of \$4208.-.

First Nickel Inc. will be doing an airborne geophysical survey over our area sometime during October and early November. Minerals they are looking for are copper and nickel which is retrieved by tunnel mining. A minimum tunnel depth of 30 metres would be required under water. (eg. West Lake) The area of most interest to them is 1 sq. km on the east side of West Lake and 3 sq. km. running south westerly for 3 km on the west side of West Lake as well as under West Lake. Minerals would have to be of a quantity to make a mine profitable which statistics show is approx. 1 in 10,000 claims filed. The next step after the aerial, if sufficient deposits are found, would be to investigate with hammer and pick and/or

sample drilling with as little surface destruction as possible. Mr Davis confirmed First Nickel Inc. would give us 3 to 6 mo.s notice if any surface drilling was to be undertaken. It must be noted that we own the surface rights to the land only and the Crown has granted the mineral rights under the land to First Nickel Inc. for exploration therefore they are not trespassing. The Ministry of Northern Development and Mines does recommend that First Nickel give us adequate notice, if possible, of their intentions. Bonnie Barham and Janet Watkins will be the contact persons for Gemm and the Rate Payers Assoc. First Nickel is not allowed to enter any lot where there are certain structures such as buildings, a garden or yard without prior consent of the owner.

Any further information received from First Nickel will be passed on to those concerned as soon as possible.
